Other recommendations	Treatment should focus on symptom management and addressing potential underlying causes. If bacterial infection is suspected, a course of oral antibiotics (such as amoxicillin) may be appropriate, while analgesics like acetaminophen or NSAIDs can help alleviate pain. Ear drops may be considered if there is significant discomfort, but caution is needed to avoid exacerbating any underlying conditions. Encourage the patient to stay hydrated, practice ear hygiene, and avoid irritants like smoking. If symptoms persist or worsen, referral to an otolaryngologist may be necessary to rule out complications such as chronic otitis media or hearing loss.
